

Who Is SeraphSong?

SeraphSong is a member-supported group that is beginning its 23rd season. It was formed to provide choral experiences of excellence that encourage worship, provide leadership training, and offer fellowship and prayer support for women in ministry who serve in South Carolina Baptist churches. The group ministers in various venues including churches, prisons, nursing homes, and community events.

Dues-- SeraphSong dues are \$25 annually per member and due by the deadline date before the Kick-Off Retreat. Dues are non-refundable.

Concert Attire-- SeraphSong utilizes two concert outfits: the uniform concert blouse, black shell, black pants, black shoes; and the polo shirt with black pants and black shoes.

Attendance Guidelines-- All members are expected to attend the kick-off retreat in August and are considered active when they participate in at least 2/3 of rehearsals and concerts.

New members are required to attend the retreat and must register by July 1.

Membership in SeraphSong is open to the following:

- Ministers of Music/Music Directors in the local church
- Spouses of male church staff members
- Female Music Ministerial staff of church
- Church accompanists (*pianist, organist, keyboardist*)
- Professional church musicians (*Baptist University professors, vocational music evangelists, etc.*)
- Active qualified church musicians who read music, on the recommendation of a SeraphSong member and the candidate's music director; and upon approval of SeraphSong leadership.

In addition to our love for music, we have a passion for missions. An offering is received at concerts to support various ministries such as Connie Maxwell Children's Home and SC Baptist Ministries to the Aging, projects at Camp La Vida and SC Correctional institutions for women, and for scholarships to SC Baptist Universities for women preparing for music ministry, and other worthy causes. For example, we provided iPods, hand bells, and a sound system to a nursing home.

SeraphSong is committed to impacting our world for Christ.
